Transcribers Needed

Greetings from Media Operations. We need to put together a team of volunteers who can transcribe sermons (and perhaps occasionally other audio/video projects) for posting on the member website. Everyone can benefit from having transcriptions, of course, but they help in particular those who are hearing impaired. In addition, we've had requests for transcriptions for those who don't have Internet access in order to provide them with a greater level of spiritual food.

We simply don't have the time or resources at the office to devote to filling this need, but we know that there are probably a number of members who would be delighted to serve in this project. The following are the general requirements for a transcriber:

- Basic computer and word processing skills.
- Good typing skills.
- Good knowledge of language and grammar rules. We will provide basic style guidelines, but you still need to have a good grasp of proper punctuation, capitalization, subjectverb agreement, etc.
- An attention to quality control, which is mainly the ability to carefully proofread and self-edit your work before sending it in.

- Free transcription software is available, but you may want to purchase a foot pedal.
- Previous dictation and transcription experience is not essential, but it is certainly a plus.

The time required would vary, of course; but we would adjust the assignments to fit each person's schedule. We plan on organizing the transcription team as soon as possible, and further information will be provided at that time.
