2015 Feast Registration

This is the weekend for Festival Registration!

To follow up on the Feast registration announcement we made last week, we want to remind everyone that this year's registration process is different

from what you have been accustomed to in the past.

We are implementing a new database system that will make registration much easier for you and more accurate for our Feast administration. However, the efficiency of this new system is dependent on our having the most accurate and up-to-date information possible, and that is why we need your careful attention for the following.

This year, Feast registration is a two-step process.

1) Preregistration to verify contact information:

We need every individual in the U.S. who is 18 or over, as well as any high school graduates who are under the age of 18, to *first* "preregister" in order to verify his or her email address. (Only do this one time.)

Important: **Each person** should verify his or her email address, even if two or more of you use the same email address and even if you are planning to attend the Feast overseas.

Preregistration is quick and easy, but very important. You should have received by now an email with the link. It's http://feast.cogwa.org/preregister.

If not, please see our Feast advisor (Mr. Flynn in East Texas this Sabbath) and he will provide it for you. It will take only a few seconds to complete a

short form that asks for your name, email address, birth date and the name of the congregation you attend. Please do not put more than one person's name in each form and please double-check to make sure that all information is accurate!

You will receive a thank you note and instructions on or before April 19 on how to register for the Feast. Please note that the personalized link you are sent will not work until tomorrow, April 19, and that registration will include every site for COGWA, including all international sites.

For those of you who do not have Internet access or an email address, please contact your local Festival adviser, Mr. Eric Case (East Texas) or Mr. Chris Teague (Ruston), to let him know where you wish to attend and how many in your household will be attending. The Festival adviser will take that information and register for you.

2) The second step is the actual Feast registration tomorrow, April 19 (any time):

When you register, you will be asked to list your first and second choices of Feast sites. We really believe that everyone will likely get their FIRST CHOICE, considering all the new sites we have this year.

Is Foundation Institute, Center for Biblical Education, for you? What's it like to study one year of Bible at the headquarters of the Church of God, a Worldwide Association? We asked some of this year's students to comment.

One current student says, "I've never been so happy to be outside of my 'comfort zone.'
