Once you have registered for WFW, you should receive a confirmation email that will also contain a link for you to book your room at the Galt House Hotel (GHH). We've found that some of the confirmation emails are being designated as spam, so if you don't receive the confirmation email, please check for it in your spam/junk folder.

If you register for WFW and are planning on staying at the GHH, you must make separate reservations with the hotel. Please take note—the deadline for making hotel reservations is **Dec. 16.**

There have been some questions regarding the dates available for the hotel rooms. Please understand the GHH has default dates of Tuesday, Dec. 24, to Saturday, Dec. 28, that are posted when you arrive at the GHH group room landing page. If you use this default setting, the GHH will have you checking in Tuesday, Dec. 24, and checking out Saturday morning, Dec. 28. Please understand, the dates can be modified to your plans.

If you are using a desktop or laptop computer, simply select your arrival and departure dates, and then click the "Update" icon. If you are using a mobile device, you will see dates at the top of the screen with an "Edit" icon just to the right of the dates. Click on the "Edit" icon, select your dates, and then close out.
