Feast of Tabernacles in Cortona, Italy, and Ashbourne, Ireland

Those who registered for the Feast of Tabernacles in Cortona, Italy, and Ashbourne, Ireland, will be notified of their acceptance via email this week. Since we still have openings in Italy, and a very short waiting list for Ireland, we will be reopening registration for these sites beginning Sunday, Feb. 9, at 12:01 a.m. Central time,

and ending at midnight on Monday, Feb. 10.

Acceptances for those who register on these February dates will be based on a lottery system, so there is no need to race to register – as long as you do so within the two-day period. More information about these two Feast sites is available on the COGWA Feast website (feast.cogwa.org).

IMPORTANT: Before you start the registration process, make sure you go into the portal and check that all the information for you and your family members and dependents is up to date. You will not be able to do this during the registration process.

Registrations will be accepted online only. When it's time to register, go to the COGWA portal (portal.cogwa.org) and log into your account. Then click the Feast registration button. Make sure your email address is correct, as this will be the address to which all communication will be sent. Then click "Next" to go to the Volunteer and Special Music sign-up page. Please confirm where you wish to volunteer. Then click the button complete your registration.

After completing your registration, you will receive a confirmation email right away

Remember that you have 48 register—from hours to Sunday, Feb. 9. through Monday, Feb. 10. We ask that those who register should be serious about planning to attend Please accepted. don't attempt to "hold a space just in case Î could go." Please count the cost first.

Each household with dependents register must separately. Please do not add other friends or family members who do not live with you or who have their own portal account. They will need to register separately. If you must travel and Feast together with others, and wish to be accepted or rejected as a group, please indicate this in the text box titled "Other non-household members in your group" at the bottom of the page.

We plan to notify those who register in February in this second round, whether they have been accepted or have been placed on the waiting list by Feb. 19. Those who are accepted will receive additional information.
