We'd like to make you aware that *Snapshot*, the pictorial of our 2024 COGWA Youth Camps, has been given a new home. Pictures of camper dorms and staff members are featured in this online publication. Since the pictorial has photos of minors and their names—and we are required to follow strict online privacy laws—*Snapshot* needs to be password-protected. To access *Snapshot 2024*, follow these steps:

1. First, contact the director of the camp you attended last year to obtain your personal *Snapshot* login credentials.

2. Once you have these credentials, go to camps.cogwa.org.
3. Right below the banner with this year's camp theme ("Seek First the Kingdom"), you'll see a blue bar for *Snapshot*. Click "view," and it will take you to the login page.
4. Type in your credentials and enjoy the photos! (Note! Please do not share your login credentials with others.)

While *Snapshot 2024* is an online-only publication, in 2025, in addition to the free online version, we plan to make printed copies of *Snapshot 2025* available for advance purchase. When you apply for camp, you can order your copy by clicking on the *Snapshot* check box. The system will automatically add \$6.75 to your total camp fees to cover printing and mailing. Your address in the camp application system must be correct in order for you to receive your copy. (Winter Camp photos will be added later, but only to the online version.) The CYC application system for our 2025 summer camps should open early next month.
