Teen Camp Change for 2026

As Doug Horchak announced during *In Accord*, this was the last year we conducted the Northeast teen camp at Heritage Reservation in southwest Pennsylvania. The primary reason we are moving the Northeast camp location is because the only dates Heritage

would be available to us are very late in the summer. By that time, many potential campers have already begun school activities, such as sports practices or band rehearsals, and some have already begun their regular school year.

We have deeply appreciated the service of Scott Lord and his wife Monica, who have directed our Northeast teen camp for the last decade of our 30-year history at Heritage Reservation.

We are pleased to announce that we have secured a new camp near Delaware, Ohio, about 20 miles north of Columbus. We will begin using this camp next summer—from June 28 to July 5. The camp is Camp Lazarus, a Boy Scouts of America facility, though we are currently calling it the Northeast Teen Camp until we decide on another name.

The camp will be directed by Chad Messerly, assisted by his wife Jen, who have been serving on the Camp Team for many years. As Mr. and Mrs. Messerly move into their new role, Zach Smith, assisted by his wife Emily, will become the director of preteen Camp Arrowhead.
