Holy Day Offering Envelopes

The Church mailed holy day offering envelopes for use during the fall holy days along with the latest booklet, *What Is a True Christian?*

Using these envelopes for your holy day offerings makes processing much easier. Please

clearly print and write only on the front of the envelope:

Your complete name and mailing address as they should appear on your contribution receipt.

Your donor envelope number (printed on your annual receipt).

Any change of address. (Check the "change of address" box, but also be sure to include your name and donor number.)

A couple of notes about receipts:

If you do not want a receipt, please write "No Receipt" on the envelope.

We are legally required to issue a receipt to the person whose name appears on the envelope. If parents want a child's offering added to their record, the parent's name must be on the envelope.

All funds given in the holy day offering will be categorized as HDO for that particular holy day on your receipt. (If you want to give other funds—tithes, an offering for another holy day, etc.—please send them separately.)

Most local church areas will be processing the holy day offerings locally, so please make sure checks or money orders are made payable to:

Children’s Choir at the Feast

Dear Parents,

We’re looking forward to having children’s choirs at the Feast this year! Preparations are once again being made for our children, aged 5 to 12, to perform special music at each of our U.S. Feast sites this fall. (Some English-speaking international sites may be able to do so as well.) This year the children will be singing a piece composed by Church members Emily Smith and Judy Troyer, titled “Seek First the Kingdom of God.” Many of our preteens have already learned this song at summer camp!

In order to make the process of obtaining a rehearsal recording and lyrics as easy as possible, MP3 rehearsal tracks and PDF copies of the songs are available to all who would like to participate. We are making this information available to everyone in COGWA, so you may download the music yourself.

The music is posted on the Feast website, but due to copyright issues, it is password-protected. To download rehearsal tracks and lyrics

sheets, go to feast.cogwa.org/childrens-choir/ and enter the password **FOTmusic2025** when asked. Please note that the password is case-sensitive, so be sure to type it exactly as given here. Once you have logged into the children’s choir music page, right-click on each of the files and choose “Save link as ...” or “Save target as ...” to download the MP3 rehearsal tracks and the PDFs of the music.

We have permission from the composers to post these files and allow members who will attend the Feast with us to download and use them. However, we do ***not*** have permission to forward them to friends or repost them elsewhere. We ask that you share the password only with others planning to attend one of our COGWA Feast sites. Your help in respecting the copyright and royalty rights of the composer is greatly appreciated.
